

**South Fork Rivanna Reservoir Stewardship Task Force
Minutes of Task Force Members Field Trip to Ivy Landfill
December 18, 2008**

A meeting of the South Fork Rivanna Reservoir (SFRR) Stewardship Task Force was held on December 18, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. at the Ivy Landfill located at 4576 Dick Woods Road. The purpose of the meeting was to allow the Task Force members and their guests to view the clean-fill area where alum sludge from the South Rivanna Water Treatment Plant is deposited.

No business of the Task Force was conducted during the field trip. Task Force members present were Ms. Holly Edwards ó Charlottesville City Council, Mr. Michael Gaffney ó Rivanna Water and Sewer Authority, Ms. Karen Joyner ó Ivy Creek Foundation, and Ms. Sally Thomas ó Chair, member of the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors and representing the League of Women Voters.

Others present included Mr. Mark Brownlee ó Rivanna Solid Waste Authority (RSWA), Mr. David Atkins ó Rivanna Water and Sewer Authority (RWSA) and RSWA, and Mr. Bob Wichser, Ms. Tamara Ambler, and Mr. Tom Frederick of RWSA. Mr. Todd Niemeier and Ms. Audrey Olivier attended as guests of Ms. Holly Edwards.

After viewing the clean fill area the Task Force, out of interest, viewed the injection wells for the enhanced bioremediation system and the newly installed horizontal wells for leachate draining. The Task Force also viewed the collection system for methane and the continuous flare to eliminate gas odors, as well as the innovative "Encore Shop" that promotes reuse and recycling of reclaimed goods.
